BULK ITEM COLLECTION

One bulk item per month on first (1st) Wednesday of every month (i.e. mattress, furniture, etc.) per household is permitted.

BULK LIST

Lawnmowers: Oil and gas must be drained (medium size item)

BBQ Grills: Must have propane tank removed (medium size item) Refer to Earth911.com, 1-800-GOT-JUNK, or local twp. for proper disposal.

ALL BULK:

- Items must be less than 6ft in length to fit in the hopper.
- NO item should exceed 50lbs.
- Carpet, branches, must be tied and bundled (4ft in length max.)
- Wood, no nails.
- Sofa, recliner, mattress, box spring, must be wrapped in plastic

UNACCEPTABLE BULK ITEMS:

- Car or truck batteries
- Tires
- Waste Oil
- Paint – cans must be dry
- Insecticides
- Motors
- Tanks – welding or gas
- 55gal Metal Drums
- Asbestos
- Contaminated soil
- Medical Waste
- Concrete/Cement

ELECTRONIC WASTE (NOT ACCEPTED)

State law prohibits residents from putting covered devices such as televisions, desktop and laptop computers, monitors, keyboard and anything that connects to a computer out for trash collection.

NO HAZARDOUS WASTE

Car batteries, gasoline, motor oil, pesticides, oil-base paints and other toxic and hazardous materials do not belong in the trash!

RECYCLING COLLECTION

Recycle newspapers, inserts & junk mail, magazines, catalogs and envelopes, paper back books and phone books, cardboard, clean pizza boxes, office & school papers (colored paper), box board (cereal, cake & cracker boxes); wax juice cartons, paper egg cartons, paper bags, aluminum cans & clean foil; tin & empty steel aerosol cans, empty glass jars & bottles, and all plastic containers labeled #1-#7. Recycling should be placed curbside same with trash cans.
